## EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM Peer Model Preschool

Thank you for your interest in the Auburn School District Peer Model Preschool Program! A program for students without identified disabilities who do not have IEP services.

Registration for the 2025-26 school year will begin at **9 AM on Wednesday, March 5th.** Application forms will be accepted by email to kvelichko@auburn.wednet.edu and in person at Student Special Services, 502 4th Street NE Auburn, WA 98002.

Currently enrolled Peer Model students have the opportunity to pre-register for the 2025-26 school year prior to March 5th. Students must be pre-registered for the school that they are currently attending. Current Peer Model students who would like to switch schools will need to reapply when general registration opens.

Placement for newly enrolled students is determined by space availability and on a first come/first placed basis. Your name will be placed on the list in the order your application is received. To be equitable, we will alternate between in-person and electronic applications. Once a classroom is full, you may elect to be on the waiting list or choose to be placed into a school with an opening. As openings arise, we will contact you and you will then have the opportunity to enroll your child in a program. After the first day of school, we will not move children between programs – any openings will go to students who are not currently in program.

## EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM Peer Model Preschool

Research supports the concept of having children with identified disabilities in learning opportunities with their nondisabled peers. In order to increase the variety of opportunities for this to happen, the Auburn School District has developed a program for preschool-age children to participate in classes at all of our Early Childhood sites. This inclusive program is called Peer Model and the students without disabilities (Peer Models) have the opportunity to participate weekly in a high quality, developmentally appropriate preschool program with their peers with developmental delays. Thank you for considering enrollment in our program!

**Length of Program:** Four days per week (Tuesday through Friday) for approximately 2 ½ hours each day. There are morning and afternoon sessions at most locations.

**Program Dates:** Students attend school September through June **following the district calendar**. The district calendar is available on our website at www.auburn.wednet.edu.

Age of Children: Three- and Four-year-olds. Must be 3 by August 31, 2025.

**Cost of Program:** \$2,000 for the school year – September through June, payable in one full installment or monthly installments of \$200.

**Transportation:** Transportation is **NOT** provided by Auburn School District for Peer Model students. The family is responsible for timely transportation to and from school.



### STUDENTS WITHDRAWING FROM PROGRAM MID-YEAR:

Withdrawals must be submitted in writing two weeks prior. Please email to kvelichko@auburn.wednet.edu. **NOTE:** No reduction in the tuition amount for the year will be available if your child is withdrawn after May 15. Refunds are processed using standard Auburn School District policy and procedures. A check will be mailed to you at the address on record within 4- 6 weeks from the date of the request.

Tuition for the 2025-26 school year is \$2,000 for the year. Please refer to payment options below for information on annual and monthly payments.

No additional fees are charged for field trips or special activities. Tuition will not be prorated for reasons such as illness or vacation, and days missed cannot be deducted from your tuition fee. District wide closures affecting preschool will be reviewed on an annual basis. For your convenience, the annual tuition has been divided into ten equal payments regardless of the number of school days each month. Payment is **due on or before the first day** of each month. *If payment or payment arrangements are not received by the 10th of the month, your child will be withdrawn*.

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

Auto Deductions: Payments can be automatically withdrawn from your bank account. There is no fee for this service; contact our office for the form that will enroll you in automatic payments.

**Monthly Payments:** (Cash or checks only) Payments should be made at or mailed to Student Special Services, 502 4th Street NE Auburn, WA 98002. If you wish to pay in cash, please bring the exact amount as no change is available. Checks should be made payable to Auburn School District.

**Online Payments:** Once your student is registered, Credit or Debit card payment is available online, with a small fee. Contact our office for more information about this process.




