- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide transportation for their student, and student will be held to high standards of academic progress, behavior, and attendance in order to maintain this transfer.
- High school students who are granted a non-resident waiver are not eligible to participate in varsity athletics for one year after being enrolled in their new school unless the transfer is between the WIAA designated natural break between 8th and 9th grade years only.
- Waiver transfers may only take place at the beginning of a grading period and must be renewed annually.
- Note: Transfer requests shall be considered upon availability of space at the requested school. Requests received at the start of the school year may be held for up to two weeks after the first day of school to monitor enrollment capacity.
