

## Student Absences 20+ consecutive days

For students to be absent beyond 20 consecutive days and counted in enrollment the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The absences will not have a serious adverse effect upon the student's educational progress.
- 2) The student has not enrolled in school in another district or private school.
- 3) The student is not participating in online school or in a homeschool program.
- 4) The student is not approved for Home Hospital.
- 5) The student must return to school prior to the end of the school year.

Examples for use: Extended family trips out of the country, illnesses not covered under Home Hospital, school exclusion for vaccinations, parent-choice school exclusions, suspensions.
